Possibility of Low Pressure

Customers in Moorooroo, Bethany, Light Pass, Stockwell and north of Sturt Highway may experience lower than normal pressure and flow during peak irrigation periods for the rest of summer.

Last Saturday one pump set in Olsen (Airfield) pump station at Rowland Flat sustained significant damage. We have begun the repair process, but we expect it to take a month or more.

While the remaining pump set can meet current water requirements, additional flow may result in the pump reaching its capacity.

If you do not get the flow and pressure you expect, please check and clean your filter. If flow and pressure remain low, let us know.

Poor Water Quality

We are very aware of the current poor water quality – high solids regularly blocking filters, a persistent odour, and a deep gold or pale amber colour.

I continue to speak with SA Water about this, particularly to identify the root cause. There are, however, no easy fixes. Regular filter backwashing will be required until late summer when our water source is switched for SA Water's Warren Reservoir upgrade project.

Additional Water and Surplus Water

Customers seeking <u>additional temporary water</u> for use before 30 September 2023 can submit the linked form or contact Neville who will be able to assist.

Conversely, customers who expect to have surplus water this Water Year should consider submitting the <u>surplus temporary water</u> form sooner rather than later to have the best chance of BIL finding someone who needs it.
