Change of Water Source – Chlorinated

From Tuesday 30th March 2021 until at least July and possibly until September 2021, SA Water intend on changing BIL's water source from the Warren Reservoir to their Swan Reach system. During this time, the water supplied to BIL customers will be chlorinated. BIL customers should review their irrigation practices and make changes if deemed necessary.

Water Usage

Please monitor your water use closely. We have noticed that a number of customers are getting very close to, or exceeding, their available water allocation. If this is you, try finding another customer who can help with a [Customer to Customer](#) temporary transfer or submit a request for [Additional](#) temporary water and we will try to help.

If you have surplus water in Water Year 20/21, please submit a [Surplus](#) temporary water form so Neville can help other customers.

Water Use Invoicing

Invoicing for water use in February and March 2021 is scheduled for the first week of April. Payment on or before the due date is greatly appreciated.
