Scheme Expansion – Closedowns for New Works

The work is now proceeding quickly with upgrades to be done in May. The following is a program of works and how they will impact in various areas. Customers will not have BIL water between the dates as listed below. This information will be confirmed on the BIL web site each week as works progress.

- 1. 8 and 9 May
 - Replacement of main flowmeter all customers will be affected
- 2. 14 to 19 May

New Pipework at Whitmore Pumping Station - customers downstream of the western branch main at Rowland Flat will be affected, including Gomersal Road, Rowland Flat, Seppeltsfield, Marananga, Stonewell, Dorrien adjacent to Barossa Valley Way.

- 3. 21 to 26 May
 - New Pumps at Vinegrove Pumping Station customers north of the Sturt Highway affected <u>except</u> Research, Belvidere and Schneider Roads.
- 4. 28 May to 2 June
 - New Pumps at Moppa Pumping Station customers on Moppa Road affected
