Scheme Expansion

The construction works for the expansion have now commenced and are progressing on schedule. Cavco have been engaged to lay approximately 6 Km of 150 and 200mm pipes to connect the new storage and the existing pipe network. Laying along Ebenezer Road is complete. The contract will be complete in December. The first new KSB pump complete with a 450 KW motor has arrived at Airfield Pump Station, with the pump being flown out from Germany to meet the high water demand in January. Lyndoch Pump Station on Yaldara Drive is complete and waiting for power to be connected. Upgrades of all pumping Stations will be complete before the start of the 2018/19 irrigation season.

The contract has been let to Hunter Bros to construct a 500 ML storage at Ebenezer on land leased to BIL for 99 years by Geoff and Adrian Hoffmann. Final design by the contractor is well advanced and work on site will commence in December.
