Annual General Meeting

A reminder the Barossa Infrastructure Annual General Meeting at the Vine Inn on Monday 23 October at 4:00 pm.

Come along for an in-depth discussion on the expansion involving:

- Construction of a 500 Megalitre storage and pumping station at Ebenezer
- New pipes linking Belvidere, Research, Schneider (extension of Light Pass Rd), Kapunda Truro and Ebenezer Roads, with the storage and pumping station. Construction is well advanced
- In addition to the new pumping station at Ebenezer, there is a new pumping station at Lyndoch, completed and waiting power connection
- All existing Pumping Stations will be upgraded, including new 450 KW motors replacing the existing 340 KW motors at Airfield pumping station
- Improved controls and alarms in the operation of Pressure Reducing valves
- Connection of about 40 new properties and upgrading of a further 80 existing connections
- Variable speed drives to all pumps to maximise efficiency
- Upgrades to the Warren transfer main and pumping station, as well as improvement to the Mannum Adelaide Pipeline by SA Water
