\$100/ML Rebate to Premium and Off Peak Water Customers

At the 16 June 2026 Board meeting, the Board agreed to distribute a rebate of \$100/ML of contracted (owned) Premium and Off Peak BIL Water Entitlements held on 16 June 2026.

The rebate will be in the form of an account credit, processed onto your account this week. The credit is to be used against existing and future invoices.

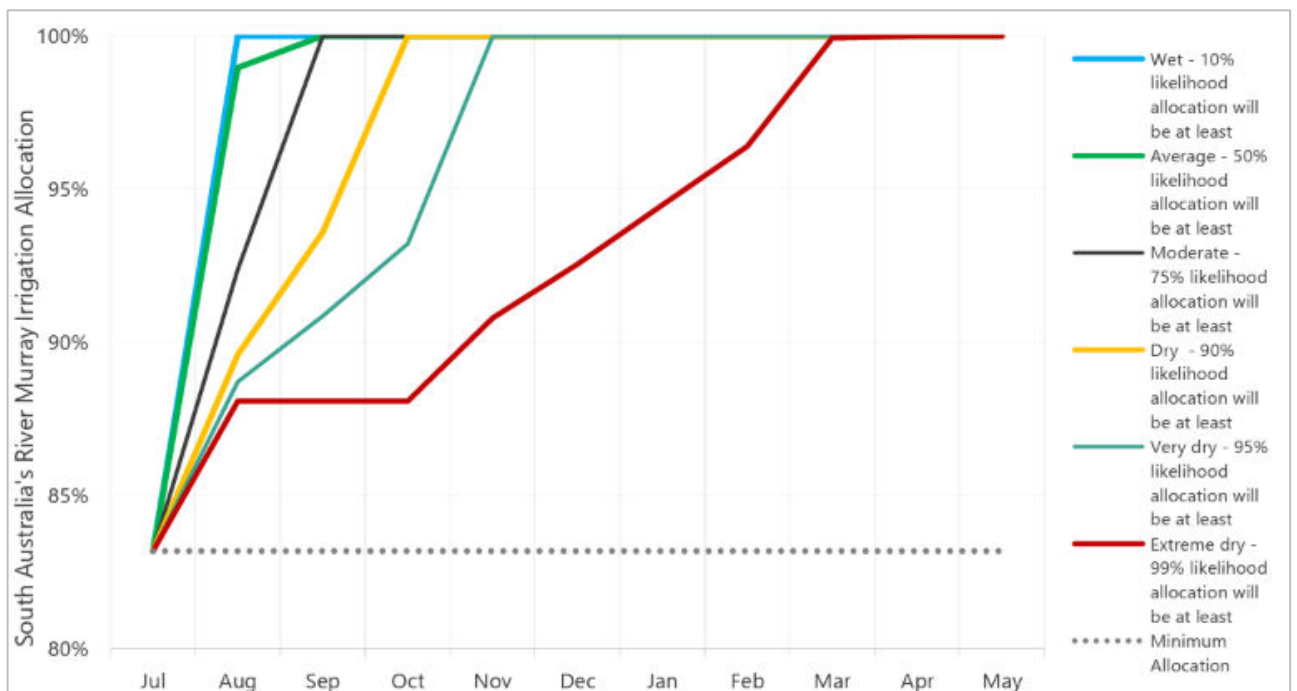
The rebate is funded by higher than budgeted water sales and interest earned on term deposits. BIL continues to have a strong balance sheet to comfortably cover this rebate and foreseeable future costs.

Although this is the third rebate in three years, the Board cautioned against assuming further rebates in future years.

River Murray Allocation Outlook

BIL’s [Drought Policy](#) is to, essentially, mirror the Department for Environment and Water’s water allocation percentage for Class 3 River Murray water.

This week [DEW released a new outlook](#) for FY27 that shows 83% allocations on 1 July 2026 and then all scenarios reaching 100% allocations. DEW’s diagram is below.



- The Moderate, Average and Wet scenarios reach 100% allocations before 1 October 2026. This impacts BIL but not BIL customers.
- The Very Dry and Dry scenarios reach 100% allocations by November. This means BIL customers will have reduced allocations at the start of BIL's Water Year. However, in practice, customers do not use 83-100% of their BIL water in the first two months of the Water Year, so there should be no or negligible impact to customers.
- The Extreme Dry scenario reaches 100% in March 2027. Over summer, allocations are in the 90-95% range. For customers that use all of their BIL water over summer, this scenario may reduce water availability during this time.

It is important to remember that this is an outlook and not a guarantee. As conditions change, so will the outlook.
