Premium Water	Water taken against your Premium Water Entitlement
Off Peak Water	Water taken against your Off Peak Water Entitlement
CWMS Premium Water	For customers supplied from the Gomersal Rd main only, a reduced rate for the proportion of Community Wastewater Management Scheme (CWMS) water taken against your Premium Water Entitlement
CWMS Off Peak Water	For customers supplied from the Gomersal Rd main only, a reduced rate for the proportion of CWMS water taken against your Off Peak Water Entitlement
Spot Water	Water taken against your Spot Water Entitlement
Reduced Price (for water not taken)	A charge payable in respect of the quantity of water not taken out of each Water Year's Premium, Off Peak or Spot Water Entitlements
Excess Water Use	Water taken in excess of your Water Entitlements
Suspension Reinstatement Fee	A charge to recover account administration and water suspension/reinstatement costs
Infrastructure Levy	A Customer's capital contribution to the scheme, payable over several years as per your Customer Contract(s)
Connection/Disconnection – Planning & Investigations	Planning and investigations in relation to a proposed connection/disconnection/modification of a customer's Water Delivery Point
Connection/Disconnection - Installation	Parts, labour, equipment hire etc for the physical connection/disconnection/modification of the customer's Water Delivery Point to/from Barossa Infrastructure Limited's network

How our Charges are Determined	
BIL is a community rated scheme operated to deliver water to customers at the lowest price sustainable over the long term.	
Water use charges vary by the same proportion and take effect at the same time as any variation in the charges BIL is liable to pay under the Water Transport Agreement with SA Water (Clause 27 of the Customer Contract).	
Variations to water use charges outside of Clause 27 is by a Special Resolution of shareholders of BIL.	
Infrastructure charges imposed on BIL by SA Water are passed through to BIL customers through the water use charges.
